**BALLOT VOTING MODEL**

This Ballot Voting Model is based on the bylaws and the Stipulations Language Worksheet for the Neighborhood Council and shall be used as the basis for distributing ballots on Election Day and as part of the Vote-By-Mail process.

The NCWP Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types.

**1) AFFIRMED STAKEHOLDER BALLOT**

Factual basis stakeholders can only vote in the following race:

- At-Large Affirmation Director - Vote for one (1)

**2) COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDER BALLOT**

All stakeholders who live, work or own property within the NCWP boundaries can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Affirmation Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 1 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 2 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 3 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 4 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 5 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 6 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 7 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 8 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 9 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 10 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 11 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 12 Director - Vote for one (1)
- Residential District 13 Director - Vote for one (1)

- Religious Director - Vote for one (1)
- Senior Citizens Director - Vote for one (1)

- Youth Organization Director - Vote for one (1)

## Summary:

- The NCWP has 31 Board seats. All **31** seats are elected by stakeholders.
- Stakeholders can use **Documentation** as a means of establishing stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age for all seats is **18**.
- NCWP has 15 Residential Districts.
  - o Voting is open to all qualified stakeholders.
  - o NCWP Districts are applicable to board representation at the time of candidate qualification/filing.
- NCWP will have staggered, four-year board terms. Per the NCWP Stipulation Language Worksheet: Group A – 16 seats (including even-numbered Residential Districts). Group B – 15 seats (including odd-numbered Residential Districts).
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
