**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Board pass the motion transmitted to it by the Governmental Affairs/City Services Committee as stated below.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the Committee Meeting on April 21<sup>st</sup> the Committee heard a presentation from representatives from the Playa Vista Homeowner's Association (PVPAL) regarding its request from the support of the Committee and the NCWP in seeking the establishment of Overnight Parking Districts (OPDs) restricting parking from the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily for the following streets within Playa Vista community: Bluff Creek between Lincoln and Dawn Creek; Villosa Place between Seawalk Drive and Kiyot Way; Agustin Place between Celedon Creek and Dawn Creek; and Crescent Park East and West.

**DISCUSSION:**

A number of Playa Vista residents were in attendance at the Committee meeting and voiced their support for the establishment of the OPDs for the designated streets. The residents expressed concerns that without establishment of the OPDs the streets in question would be used for long term parking of recreational vehicles, water craft and other vehicles left parked on the streets for extended periods of time, restricting available parking for residents and their guests. The Playa Vista Homeowner's Association's (PVPAL) Board of Directors recently passed a motion in support of the creation of OPDs for the identified streets, and the Committee was advised that PVPAL was not aware of any opposition to the establishment of OPDs for the designated streets. No speakers appeared and spoke in opposition to the request during the public comment period.

Following a question and answer session a motion was presented to support the establishment of OPDs for the designated streets, and the motion was approved unanimously by the Committee.
