**Your neighborhood has seen a recent increase in Burglaries. This community alert is to provide you with information on how to protect your home and vehicle from crime. In the majority of the burglaries the suspect has entered the residence through an unlocked door or open window. Most of our vehicle break-ins occur when citizens leave items visible in the passenger compartment of the vehicle.**

#### YOUR HOME

- LOCK YOUR WINDOWS AND DOOR WHEN YOU ARE NOT HOME.
- SECURE THE GATES AND FENCES AROUND YOUR HOME.
- KEEP YOUR GARAGE CLOSED.
- KEEP LIGHTS ON WHEN YOU ARE NOT HOME.
- DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS OF VALUE VISABLE
- LOCK YOUR BICYCLES
- GET TO KNOW YOUR NEIGHBORS
- SECURE YOU VALUABLES SUCH AS LAPTOP COMPUTERS, JEWELRY, AND ELECTRONICS AT HOME.
- LEAVE A TELEVISION OR RADIO ON WHEN YOU ARE NOT HOME.
- POST SECURITY SIGNS
- INSTAL MOTION LIGHTS AND SECURITY CAMERAS

#### YOUR VEHICLE

- LOCK THE CAR DOORS
- CLOSE ALL THE WINDOWS
- DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS OF VALUE VISABLE IN YOUR VEHICLE.

Call the police if you see a suspicious person on either yours or your neighbor's property. Document license plates of suspicious persons in your neighborhood.
