Construction of a new 54-inch diameter force main sewer line to operate as a parallel system in conjunction with the existing sewer line. The project will increase capacity, create pipeline redundancy and allow for maintenance.

Work planned for April 2018 through May 2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rebar installation • Concrete pouring for shaft caissons • Crane operation and movement • This will include: Pre-excavation of the shaft; concrete and asphalt demolition; equipment and material deliveries; mobilization and demobilization of construction equipment
Where is the construction area?	Activities will occur at the following location: Pacific Avenue at 62 nd Avenue
What time are crews scheduled to work?	Expected work hours are: Mon – Fri, 7am – 7pm, Sat 8am – 5pm
What can I expect?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Noise associated with heavy equipment • Minimal vibration due to construction work • Construction traffic including large equipment deliveries, dump trucks, and concrete trucks
Is local access impacted?	Through traffic will be maintained for local traffic access at all times. Driveway access will be maintained for businesses and residents including for deliveries and trash pickup.
Safety Measures (to protect the public and construction crew)	Appropriate traffic handling measures will be implemented to safely divert traffic through the construction zone. Safety barriers will be used in all construction areas.
